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12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
13	1. That § 54.1-2301, as it is currently effective, of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted
14	as follows:
15	§ 54.1-2301. (Effective until July 1, 2016) Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works
16	Operators and Onsite Sewage System Professionals; membership; terms; duties.
17	A. The Board for Waterworks and Wastewater Works Operators and Onsite Sewage System
18	Professionals shall consist of 11 members as follows: the Director of the Office of Water Programs of
19 20	the State Department of Health, or his designee, the Executive Director of the State Water Control
20	Board, or his designee, a currently employed waterworks operator having a valid license of the highest
21 22	classification issued by the Board, a currently employed wastewater works operator having a valid
22 23	license of the highest classification issued by the Board, a faculty member of a state university or college whose principal field of teaching is management or operation of waterworks or wastewater
23 24	college whose principal field of teaching is management or operation of waterworks or wastewater works, a representative of an owner of a waterworks, a representative of an owner of a wastewater
24 25	works, a licensed alternative on all owner of a waterworks, a licensed alternative onsite sewage system operator, a licensed alternative onsite sewage system
23 26	installer, a licensed anternative onsite sewage system operator, a neensed anternative onsite sewage system
20 27	operator, alternative onsite sewage system installer, and onsite soil evaluator shall have practiced for at
28	least five consecutive years immediately prior to appointment. No owner shall be represented on the
29	Board by more than one representative or employee operator. The term of Board members shall be four
30	years.
31	B. The Board shall examine waterworks and wastewater works operators and issue licenses. The
32	licenses may be issued in specific operator classifications to attest to the competency of an operator to
33	supervise and operate waterworks and wastewater works while protecting the public health, welfare and
34	property and conserving and protecting the water resources of the Commonwealth.
35	C. The Board shall establish a program for licensing individuals as onsite soil evaluators, onsite
36	sewage system installers, and onsite sewage system operators.
37	D. The Board, in consultation with the Board of Health, shall adopt regulations for the licensure of
38	(i) onsite soil evaluators; (ii) installers of alternative onsite sewage systems, as defined in § 32.1-163;
39	and (iii) operators of alternative onsite sewage systems, as defined in § 32.1-163. Such regulations shall
40	include requirements for (a) minimum education and training, including approved training courses; (b)
41	relevant work experience; (c) demonstrated knowledge and skill; (d) application fees to cover the costs
42	of the program, renewal fees, and schedules; (e) the division of onsite soil evaluators into classes, one of
43	which shall be restricted to the design of conventional onsite sewage systems; (f) the division of sewage
44	system installers into classes, one of which shall be restricted to the installation of conventional onsite
45 46	sewage systems; and (g) other criteria the Board deems necessary.
46 47	E. The Board shall not require applicants for initial licensure as a conventional <i>or alternative</i> onsite
47 48	sewage system installer or a conventional or alternative onsite sewage system operator to pass an examination prior to issuance of such license provided that the applicant satisfactorily demonstrates to
40 49	the Board that he has been actively engaged in performing the duties of a conventional onsite sewage
50	system installer for at least eight years within the 12-year period immediately preceding the date of
50 51	application for licensure.
52	F. The Board shall permit any wastewater works operator to sit for the conventional onsite sewage
53	system operator examination.
54	2. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.
