9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 9.1-1101.1 as follows:
11	§ 9.1-1101.1. Physical evidence recovery kits; inventory.
12	The Department shall create and maintain an inventory of all physical evidence recovery kits
13	collected by the Department of State Police or a local law-enforcement agency in connection with a
14	criminal investigation that have not been submitted to the Department for analysis prior to July 1, 2014.
15	Arrangements shall be made between the Department and the Department of State Police and local
16	law-enforcement agencies to submit such physical evidence recovery kits to the Department by January
17	1, 2015.
18	2. That the Department of Forensic Science shall prescribe the form and manner in which the
19	Department of State Police and local law-enforcement agencies shall submit the information
20	required in the first enactment of this act.
21	3. That the Department of Forensic Science shall submit a report to the General Assembly
22	summarizing the results of its inventory prior to the 2015 Regular Session of the General
23	Assembly. Such report shall also include a plan for analyzing all physical evidence recovery kits
24	submitted pursuant to the first enactment of this act.
