**SENATE BILL NO. 662**

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE**

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services  
on January 31, 2014)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Favola)

*A BILL to allow any county operating under the urban county executive form of government to continue using a local sliding scale in determining copayment responsibilities for families receiving child-care subsidy.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

*1. § 1. That any county operating under the urban county executive form of government shall be permitted to determine copayment responsibilities for families receiving child-care subsidy based on a local sliding scale that sets copayment amounts between 2.5 and 10 percent of the families' countable monthly income.*

**2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on July 1, 2016.**
