4. Title: Chief and assistant chief election officers; appointment, qualifications and terms of officers.

5. Summary: Elections; officers of elections; chief and assistant chief election officers. Requires the chief and assistant chief election officers to be nonpartisan if a representative for one or both of the two political parties receiving the highest and next highest number of votes in the preceding gubernatorial election is unavailable.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No state fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections (SBE) indicates that this bill should not have a material fiscal impact on SBE or localities. The tracking of officer party affiliations is already required.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: All localities

11. Other Comments: This revised fiscal impact statement corrects the State Board of Elections agency name. SBE will become the Department of Elections effective July 1, 2014.
