5. Summary: The legislation adds graduate assistants to the number of graduate students used to calculate the total value of unfunded scholarships annually awarded to graduate students and clinical faculty.

Fiscal Implications: The legislation adds language to include graduate assistants, along with teaching assistants and research assistants, to the number of graduate students and clinical faculty used to determine the value of unfunded scholarships awarded annually at each of the public institutions of higher education. This will provide consistency to colleges and universities on how to report unfunded scholarships and cleans up the language for graduate student employment.
