Summary: The enrolled bill directs the Department of Health Professions to consider any issues related to use of implantable medical devices distributed by medical device distributors in which a physician has an ownership interest and to report to the Governor and the General Assembly by November 1, 2014. The department must actively involve and include in the report any information provided by interested stakeholders.
