3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Commonwealth Transportation Board; membership.

5. Summary: Increases from 18 to 22 the membership of the Commonwealth Transportation Board by adding four citizen members to be appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly. Of the four new members, one is to be from the Hampton Roads highway construction district, one is to be from the Northern Virginia highway construction district, and two are to be from rural areas.

8. Fiscal Implications: There will be some minor expenses associated with updating maps, manuals, and related materials, but these can be absorbed as part of routine business operations associated with annual updates to Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) materials after each legislative session.
