- **5. Summary:** Party nomination methods. Provides that no political party shall determine its candidates for statewide or General Assembly district office by a method that prohibits absentee ballots from being cast by uniformed-service voters or otherwise eligible voters who are employed overseas under a contract with the U.S. Department of Defense.

- **8.** Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections (SBE) indicates that this legislation has no direct fiscal impact.

- **11. Other Comments:** This bill is similar to SB507. This revised version notes that the costs of a statewide primary are provided for informational purposes only.
