Summary: The proposed legislation would prohibit an incident that occurs in any setting other than on a school bus, on school property, or at a school-sponsored activity from being deemed sufficient cause for the suspension or expulsion of a student, except in cases in which the division superintendent has received a report of an adjudication of delinquency or a conviction for a certain criminal offense. The bill would narrow the scope and location of disciplinary infractions that may result in student suspension or expulsion.
