4. Title: Governor and Attorney General; parties to litigation with state, prohibited conduct, penalties.

5. Summary: Prohibited conduct; Governor and Attorney General; parties to litigation with the state; penalties. Prohibits acceptance by the Governor or Attorney General of campaign contributions or gifts worth more than \$50 from parties who oppose the state in ongoing litigation and prohibits making such contributions and gifts. The bill imposes civil penalties.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of the bill are not expected to create a cost to the Office of the Governor and Office of the Attorney General and Department of Law.
