4. Title: Special license plates; armed forces

5. Summary: This bill allows disabled veterans who have been honorably discharged to receive special license plates that are already developed for certain branches of the United States armed forces. The bill also makes a technical change by moving the Coast Guard plate from an Act of Assembly to the Code of Virginia and removes authorization for issuance of special license plates that were authorized in 2013 but did not meet minimum order requirements.

8. Fiscal Implications: Revenues collected by the Department of Motor Vehicles for these plates will cover any costs of issuing them.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles.
