**5. Summary:** Requires every attorney for the Commonwealth to establish a multidisciplinary child sexual abuse response team to conduct regular reviews of cases involving child sexual abuse in the jurisdiction. The bill has a delayed effective date.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill is not expected to impact state funding. The fiscal impact on localities is indeterminate.
