4. Title: Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA); disclosure pursuant to court order or subpoena.

5. Summary: The enrolled bill provides that nothing in FOIA shall have any bearing upon disclosures required to be made pursuant to any court order or subpoena; Nor shall any discretionary exemption from mandatory disclosure be construed to make records covered by such discretionary exemption privileged under the rules of discovery, unless disclosure is otherwise prohibited by law.

Fiscal Implications: Fiscal impact is indeterminate as it is unclear as to whether the provisions of this bill will impact state government operations, and it is unknown how often an issue might arise that will incite the stipulations of the bill.
