**4. Title:** Charter schools; funding.

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation would require local school boards to provide per pupil funding to charter schools by lump sum payment and not on a categorical basis.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** None.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill amends the method local school divisions are to use to transfer funding to charter schools. The bill does not impact state finances.

Any local fiscal impact cannot be determined at this time since the per pupil funding provided to the charter school by the local school board or, in the case of a regional public charter school, the relevant school boards, is negotiated in the charter agreement for each charter school.
