**5. Summary:** This bill requires the assessment performed by state agencies on imposed local mandates to include the identification of sources of funding for the mandate.

Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Housing and Community Development, the template used by agencies to complete the assessment requests that agencies indicate separately the source of the state, federal, and local contributions to the cost of implementing the mandate as a percentage of the total cost of implementation. As such, the information added to the assessment by this bill is already collected. Thus, it is anticipated that this bill will not result in additional costs for the department or other state agencies.
