**4. Title:** Convention to amend the United States Constitution; selection and participation of Virginia.

**5. Summary:** The bill provides for the selection by the General Assembly of delegates and alternates to attend the convention, for instructions to the delegates and alternates, for their oath to adhere to the instructions, for the appointment of observers, and for the power to recall delegates, alternates, and observers.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is unknown how often a convention would be held in any given year, thus, the fiscal impact of the bill is indeterminate. Further, while the per diem for each delegate is \$200 a day should they go to the convention, the bill does not specify how many delegates would be appointed.
