4. Title: Fire Services Board; meetings.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation provides for the Virginia Fire Services Board (VFSB) to meet no more than six times each calendar year. Under current law, the Board is limited to meeting no more than four times per calendar year.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: Yes. Item 398.

8. Fiscal Implications: Based upon the prior fiscal year's expenditures, it is estimated that each additional meeting convened within a fiscal year would cost \$5,500. Currently, the VFSB convenes four (4) full Board meetings per year. If the Board would revert to having six (6) meetings per year, the cost of two (2) additional meetings is estimated at \$11,000 per a fiscal year.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Fire Programs is the fiscal agent for the Virginia Fire Services Board (VFSB).
