3. Committee: Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

4. Title: Stormwater management programs; clarifies appeals process for persons subject to permit requirement.

5. Summary: Clarifies the appeals process for persons subject to state permit requirements under the Stormwater Management Act. The bill removes Virginia Stormwater Management Program (VSMP) authorities from the list of bodies whose actions may be appealed. For appeals of actions of the Department of Environmental Quality (the Department) or the State Water Control Board (the Board), the bill refers to applicable hearing procedures and provides that appeals include an opportunity with judicial review in accordance with certain standards.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary, see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Environmental Quality, this bill has no State fiscal impact. Also, it is uncertain as to whether or not this legislation would have a fiscal impact on the court system.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Environmental Quality, the judicial system, and localities.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: This is a companion bill to SB425.
