4. Title: School boards; annual workforce summit.

5. Summary: The bill would require each local school board to annually host a workforce summit at which members of the local business community, including representatives from the local Chamber of Commerce or other similar organization, shall provide information on the workforce skills necessary to meet the workforce demands of the local business community and ways in which elementary and secondary education can better foster such skills.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would amend the duties of a local school board to require it to host a workforce summit and solicit input from the local business community. The bill would not require the state to provide funding for this purpose. While there may be a cost to localities to host the summits, the proposed legislation would not impact state finances.
