4. Title: Renewal of concealed handgun permit; no fees required.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation provides that a person who has previously been issued a concealed handgun permit does not have to pay any fees to renew such permit.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Tentative. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of State Police (Department), the proposal has no fiscal impact on the Department.

Under current law, the Department may charge a fee not to exceed \$5 to cover its costs associated with processing the concealed handgun application. The fee collected by the Department is deposited into the general fund. On average, between FY2011-FY20013, the Department collected \$420,000 each year.

As the amount of deposited fees fluctuates annually, it is not possible to estimate exact anticipated negative impact on the Commonwealth's revenue.
