4. Title: Transportation; Commonwealth priority of projects and funding.

5. Summary: Provides that all state funds expended on transportation projects be for (i) projects expected to provide congestion reduction or (ii) projects that increase safety for travelers.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminant. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The required development of new policies and procedures will apply to transportation agencies. This development and the potential need for training and materials will impact Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) and Department of Rail and Public Transportation. (DRPT) These costs are unknown. Potential reporting requirements may require additional resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: VDOT and DRPT.
