**3. Committee:** Passed Both Houses

**4. Title:** Powers and duties of health regulatory boards; special conference committees

**5. Summary:** The enrolled bill allows special conference committees to consider applications for a license, certificate, registration, permit or issuance of a multistate licensure privilege and may grant or deny the application or issue a restricted license, certification, registration, permit, or multistate licensure privilege. The bill also provides that special conference committees may hear cases in which a holder of a permit issued by a health regulatory board is reported to be the subject of disciplinary action.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation is not expected to have any significant impact on agency revenue or practitioner fees. Moreover, it allows for the use of special conference committees which are potentially a more cost-effective option for boards and licensees.
