3. Committee: Rehabilitation and Social Services

4. Title: Felons; weekend jail time.

5. Summary: Allows the court to sentence a felon to nonconsecutive days or weekend jail time if the felony was not an "act of violence" as defined in § 19.2-297.1, and the active portion of the sentence remaining to be served is 120 days or less. The bill also eliminates the provision that nonconsecutive days or weekend jail time is for the purpose of allowing the defendant to retain employment.
