**3. Committee:** Passed Both Houses.

**4. Title:** Auctioneers; exemption from licensure.

**5. Summary:** Requires an organization to be a charitable organization granted tax-exempt status under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code in order to be exempt from licensure as an auctioneer or auction firm for sales, not exceeding one sale per year, by or on behalf of the organization. The current exemption does not specify that the organization be charitable and granted tax-exempt status.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No state fiscal impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.
