5.	Summary: Authorizes the Marine Resources Commission to suspend for five years the tidal fishing privileges of any commercial fisherman who has violated the tidal fishery laws five times or more in a two-year period. Also, allows an appeal from the Commission's decision to the court system.

7.	Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8, below.
8.	Fiscal Implications: According to the Marine Resources Commission, this bill may impact agency revenues; however, the magnitude of the impact is indeterminate at this time. It is anticipated that if commercial tidal fishing privileges are suspended for five years, then the sale of fishing licenses and resulting revenue to the Marine Resources Commission and the Marine Products Board would decline slightly.
