**4. Title:** Charter schools; enrollment.

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation would authorize local school boards to require that current students of an existing public school that is to be converted into a public charter school and their siblings be given enrollment priority over the open enrollment lottery. The bill contains an emergency clause.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** None.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill would impact the eligibility of students attending charter schools when the schools are converted from existing public schools. The bill is not expected to have a state fiscal impact. There may be an administrative cost to local school divisions to ensure students are enrolled in compliance with the legislation. Any such local impact cannot be determined at this time.
