**4. Title:** New birth certificate registration

**5. Summary:** This bill requires the State Registrar of Vital Records to, upon request, establish and register a new certificate of birth that does not state that the certificate is not evidence of United States citizenship for the child for whom it is issued or for the adoptive parents for any person who has attained United States citizenship through naturalization.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Minimal.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill would have a minimal fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The bill would require that the State Registrar of Vital Records to modify an existing form, which can be absorbed in the agency's existing workload. Therefore, no budget amendment is necessary.
