4. Title: Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC); certain licensees to provide information to consumer while on premises.

5. Summary: Allows any winery, farm winery, wine importer or wine wholesaler licensee to provide to adult customers of licensed retail establishments information about wine being consumed on such premises. The bill contains an emergency enactment clause.
