**4. Title:** Criminal history record checks; sets out list of barrier crimes

**5. Summary:** The substitute legislation details the list of barrier crimes for individuals seeking employment and volunteering at facilities and programs licensed by the Departments of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, Virginia Department of Health, Social Services, and private schools. In addition, this bill requires the Commissioner to request and the Attorney General to provide an advisory opinion in cases where a question arises concerning the interpretation of provisions governing criminal history background checks of applicants for employment and determinations as to whether an applicant is eligible for employment. This bill also makes technical changes.
