**4. Title:** Elections; meeting of electoral board following election; adjournment.

**5. Summary:** Strikes "from day to day" to allow the board to adjourn, for example, from Wednesday to Friday for the review of provisional ballots. Present law allows the electoral board to adjourn from day to day up to seven days after the election to ascertain the results. The bill also strikes "to the following day" to allow a voter, who has offered a provisional ballot, time to provide information to the electoral board to prove that the voter is entitled to vote in the precinct pursuant to § 24.2-401, Code of Virginia.
