**4. Title:** Restricted driver's license; written offer of employment.

**5. Summary:** This bill provides that a court may authorize the issuance of a restricted driver's license to a person whose license has been suspended for failure to pay fines, etc., if he presents to the court a written offer of employment contingent upon obtaining a driver's license. Currently, the person must present to the court written verification of employment. A person issued a restricted license must petition each court that suspended his license for an installment or deferred payment agreement for the payment of such fines, etc., as a condition of keeping the restricted license.
