4. Title: Endangered and threatened species.

5. Summary: This bill allows a person to possess, breed, sell, and transport any non-native wildlife included on any federal list of endangered or threatened species when the federal designation, under the Federal Endangered Species Act, does not specifically prohibit such possession, breeding, selling or transporting. In addition, the non-native wildlife must not be included on the list of predatory or undesirable animals specified by regulations of the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries.
