**3. Committee:** Passed Both Houses

**4. Title:** Amends policies of Longwood University Board of Visitors regarding removal of visitors.

**5. Summary:** Provides that if any member of the Longwood University Board of Visitors fails to perform the duties of his office for one year without sufficient cause, the office of such visitor shall be vacated. The bill also provides that if so many of such visitors fail to perform their duties that a quorum is not met for a year, the rector, any member of the board, or the president of the University may certify such fact to the Governor and the offices of all visitors failing to attend shall be vacated.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final - No impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** No fiscal impact should result from this legislation. Visitors to the Board perform their duties on a voluntary basis, without compensation. Removing visitors from the Board will have no impact on university or state finances.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Longwood University.

**11. Other Comments:** This bill is identical to HB 1102.
