**2. Patron:** Vogel

**3. Committee:** Passed Senate.

**4. Title:** Transportation of waste kitchen grease; decal.

**5. Summary:** This bill requires certain persons transporting waste kitchen grease to affix a decal issued by the Commissioner, Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, to the outside of any vehicle used for such purpose. Current law requires the person to display his name and registration number on the vehicle in letters not less than three inches high. The substitute bill makes technical changes to the introduced bill.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary, see item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, procuring the new waste kitchen grease decals will result in an annual expense of approximately \$675. The agency is able to absorb the costs within current revenue from the registration fee paid by waste haulers.
