Under current law, jails and the Department of Corrections are required to notify the Central Criminal Records Exchange of the Department of State Police of any prisoner or inmate who is illegally present in the United States. The proposed legislation would exempt from this requirement any correctional facility that participates in the "Secure Communities"

program administered by U.S. Customs and Immigration Enforcement.

The proposed legislation could save administrators and staff of correctional facilities some time by eliminating some reporting requirements. It is not expected to have any fiscal impact.
