4. Title: Add a presentation to the educational programs for the governing boards of public institutions of higher education

Summary: This amendment in the nature of a substitute makes “Board members’ duty to the Commonwealth” as the first required presentation to be made to new governing board members during annual educational programs conducted by the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV). Members are considered to be new during the first two years of their membership. Educational programs are developed by SCHEV, in consultation with the public institutions of higher education and their governing boards.
