4. Title: Coyotes; lawful to hunt or kill on Sundays.

5. Summary: This bill makes it lawful to hunt or kill coyotes on Sundays.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any fiscal impact resulting from this bill will be minimal to the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. According to the department, there are law enforcement officers as well as other agency staff members work currently work on Sundays. The agency expects an increase in dispatch call intake during the first year of implementation. In addition, the department may need to authorize overtime for conservation officers, or hire additional officers, to enforce provisions of this bill. Any impact, however, is expected to be minimal.
