permitted by law, transports a lawful firearm, weapon, or ammunition into or out of an air carrier airport 27 28 terminal for the sole purposes, respectively, of (i) presenting such firearm, weapon, or ammunition to 29 30 U.S. Customs agents in advance of an international flight, in order to comply with federal law, (ii) checking such firearm, weapon, or ammunition with his luggage, or (iii) retrieving such firearm, 31 weapon, or ammunition from the baggage claim area. 32

Any other statute, rule, regulation, or ordinance specifically addressing the possession or 33 transportation of weapons in any airport in the Commonwealth shall be invalid, and this section shall 34 control.
