11 12	1. That § 18.2-152.7:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 18.2-152.7:1. Harassment by computer; penalty.
12 13	A. If any person, with the intent to coerce, intimidate, <i>defraud</i> , or harass any person, shall use a
13 14	computer or computer network to communicate obscene, vulgar, profane, lewd, lascivious, or indecent
15	language, or make any suggestion or proposal of an obscene nature, or threaten any illegal or immoral
16	act, he shall be is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
17	B. Any person who violates subsection A while having knowingly and intentionally assumed the
18	identity of another living individual where a reasonable person would believe that the offender is in fact
19	the individual whose identity is assumed is guilty of a Class 6 felony.
20	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
21	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot
22	be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter
23	2 of the Acts of Assembly of 2014, Special Session I, requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing
24	Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000 Pursuant to \$30,191.4 the estimated
