That §§ 33.2-2500 and 33.2-2508 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 33.2-2500. Northern Virginia Transportation Authority created. 12 13 There is hereby created a political subdivision of the Commonwealth known as the Northern Virginia 14 Transportation Authority, for purposes of this chapter referred to as "the Authority." 15 In addition to such other powers vested in the Authority by this chapter, the Authority shall have the 16 following powers and functions: 1. The Authority shall prepare a regional transportation plan for Planning District 8 that includes 17 transportation improvements of regional significance and those improvements necessary or incidental 18 thereto and shall revise and amend the plan. The plan shall have as its primary objective reducing 19 congestion in Planning District 8 to the greatest extent possible and in the most rapid and cost-effective manner. The provisions of Article 7 (§ 33.2-1928 et seq.) of Chapter 19 shall apply, mutatis mutandis, 20 21 22 to preparation of such transportation plan. 23 2. The Authority may, when a transportation plan is adopted according to subdivision 1, construct or 24 acquire, by purchase, lease, contract, or otherwise, the transportation facilities specified in such 25 transportation plan. 26 3. The Authority may enter into agreements or leases with public or private entities for the operation 27 of its facilities or may operate such facilities itself. 28 4. The Authority may enter into contracts or agreements with the counties and cities embraced by the 29 Authority, with other transportation commissions of transportation districts adjoining any county or city 30 embraced by the Authority, with any transportation authority, or with any federal, state, local, or private entity to provide, or cause to be provided, transportation facilities and services to the area embraced by 31 the Authority. Such contracts or agreements, together with any agreements or leases for the operation of 32 33 such facilities, may be used by the Authority to finance the construction and operation of transportation 34 facilities and such contracts, agreements, or leases shall inure to the benefit of any creditor of the 35 Authority. 36 Notwithstanding subdivisions 1 through 4, the Authority shall not have the power to regulate services 37 provided by taxicabs, either within municipalities or across municipal boundaries; such regulation is 38 expressly reserved to the municipalities within which taxicabs operate. 39 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the Authority may: 40 a. Acquire land or any interest therein by purchase, lease, or gift and provide transportation facilities 41 thereon for use in connection with any transportation service; b. Acquire land or any interest therein by purchase, lease, or gift in advance of the need for sale or 42 43 contribution to an agency, for use by that agency in connection with an adopted transportation plan; and c. Prepare a plan for mass transportation services with persons, counties, cities, agencies, authorities, 44 45 or transportation commissions and may further contract with any such person or entity to provide 46 necessary facilities, equipment, operations and maintenance, access, and insurance pursuant to such plan. 47 § 33.2-2508. Responsibilities of Authority for long-range transportation planning. The In fulfilling the requirements of subdivision 1 of § 33.2-2500, the Authority shall be responsible 48 49 for long-range transportation planning for regional transportation projects in Northern Virginia. In carrying out this responsibility, the Authority shall, on the basis of a regional consensus whenever 50 51 possible, set regional transportation policies and priorities for regional transportation projects. The 52 policies and priorities In doing so, the Authority shall (i) give priority to projects that most effectively 53 reduce congestion in the most congested corridors and intersections, (ii) be guided by performance-based criteria such as the ability to improve travel times, reduce delays, connect regional 54 55 activity centers, improve safety, improve air quality, and move the most people in the most cost-effective manner, and (iii) document in quantitative terms the reduction in congestion and 56 improvement in regional mobility in Planning District 8 expected by implementing the plan required by 57 58 subdivision 1 of § 33.2-2500. Each locality embraced by the Authority shall report to the Authority at

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59 *least annually any elements of its comprehensive plan that are not consistent with the plan required by* **60** *subdivision 1 of § 33.2-2500.*
