Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 51.1-305 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 51.1-305. Service retirement generally.

9 A. Normal retirement. - Any member in service at his normal retirement date with five or more years 10 of creditable service may retire upon written notification to the Board setting forth the date the retirement is to become effective. 11

12 B. Early retirement. - Any member in service who has either (i) attained his fifty-fifth birthday with 13 five or more years of creditable service or (ii) in the case of a member of any of the previous systems immediately prior to July 1, 1970, complied with the requirements for retirement set forth under the 14 15 provisions of such previous system as in effect immediately prior to July 1, 1970, may retire upon written notification to the Board setting forth the date the retirement is to become effective. 16

B1. Mandatory retirement. - Any member who attains 70 73 years of age shall be retired 20 days 17 after the convening of the next regular session of the General Assembly. However, if the mandatory 18 retirement provisions of this subdivision would require a member of the State Corporation Commission 19 to be retired before the end of his elected term and such retirement would occur during a session of the 20 21 General Assembly in which the General Assembly is required, pursuant to § 12.1-6, to elect another member or members of the State Corporation Commission to serve either a regular term or a portion of 22 23 a regular term, such member who otherwise would be subject to the mandatory retirement provisions of 24 this subdivision shall be retired upon the first to occur of (i) the expiration of the term to which he was 25 elected or (ii) 20 days after the commencing of the regular session of the General Assembly that 26 immediately follows the date such member attains 72 years of age. The provisions of this subsection 27 shall apply only to those members who are elected or appointed to an original or subsequent term 28 commencing after July 1, 1993 following his seventy-third birthday.

29 C. Deferred retirement for members terminating service. - Any member who terminates service after 30 five or more years of creditable service may retire under the provisions of subsection A or B of this 31 section, if he has not withdrawn his accumulated contributions prior to the effective date of his 32 retirement or if he has five or more years of creditable service for which his employer has paid the 33 contributions and such contributions cannot be withdrawn. For the purposes of this subsection, any 34 requirements as to the member being in service shall not apply.

35 D. Effective date of retirement. - The effective date of retirement shall be after the last day of service of the member, but shall not be more than 90 days prior to the filing of the notice of retirement. 36

37 E. Notification of retirement. - In addition to the notice to the Board required by this section, the 38 same notice shall be given by the member to his appointing authority. If a member is physically or 39 mentally unable to submit written notification of his intention to retire, the member's appointing 40 authority may submit notification to the Board on his behalf.

41 2. That the provisions of this act shall apply to justices of the Supreme Court of Virginia and 42 judges of the Court of Appeals of Virginia effective July 1, 2015.

43 3. That the provisions of this act shall apply only to those judges of the circuit, general district, and juvenile and domestic relations district courts who are elected or appointed to an original or 44 45 subsequent term commencing on or after July 1, 2015.
