10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 2.2-2001.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 2.2-2001.2. Programs to create employment opportunities for veterans and assist transitioning
13	veterans.
14	A. The Department shall develop establish a comprehensive program to reduce unemployment among
15	create employment opportunities for veterans by assisting businesses to attract, hire, train, and retain
16	veterans. Such program shall promote strategies for connecting employers to qualified veterans and
17	include (i) a workforce assessment education and training program for participating employers and (ii) a
18	certification process for participating employers with the objective of setting measurable goals for hiring
19	and retaining veterans. Members of the Virginia National Guard and Virginia residents in the Armed
20	Forces Reserves not in active federal service shall be eligible for the program established under this
21	subsection.
22	B. The Department shall establish a program to assist transitioning veterans in connecting with
23	employment, education, and entrepreneurial opportunities and to educate participating veterans and
24 25	veteran services providers about available resources and opportunities. Former members of the Virginia National Guard and of the Armed Forces Reserves shall be eligible for the program established under
25 26	this subsection provided such members (i) were discharged or released under conditions other than

dishonorable and (ii) the discharge or release from the Virginia National Guard or the Armed Forces Reserves occurred less than one year prior to the date on which assistance is being sought. As used in this subsection, "transitioning veteran" means a veteran who was discharged or released 27 28 29

30 from active service less than one year prior to the date on which assistance is being sought. HB2133
