14	1. That §§ 58.1-3650.13, 58.1-3650.14, 58.1-3650.79, and 58.1-3650.246 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
16	§ 58.1-3650.13. Real Except for real property located in Frederick County, real property owned by
17	the Potomac Appalachian Trail Club, limited to sections of the Appalachian Trail and camping sites,
18	shelters and other facilities related to the Appalachian Trail and designated as such by the Division of
19	Parks of the Department of Conservation and Economic Development so long as such property is used
20	solely for public park and playground purposes, is hereby classified and designated as tax exempt under
21	Section 6 (a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia and is hereby determined to be exempt
22 23	from taxation, State and local, including inheritance taxes. § 58.1-3650.14. The Except for property located in Frederick County, the Nature Conservancy, so
23 24	long as it continues to operate on a nonprofit basis, is hereby classified and designated as organized for
25	public park purposes within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
26	Property owned by The Nature Conservancy, and used by it exclusively for conservation and public park
27	purposes on a nonprofit basis is hereby determined to be exempt from taxation.
28	§ 58.1-3650.79. Property of The People-to-People Health Foundation, IncA. Except for property
29	located in Frederick County, The People-to-People Health Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit organization, is
30 31	hereby classified and designated as a benevolent and charitable corporation within the context of Section $f(a)$ (6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia
31 32	6 (a) (6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.B. Property Except for property located in Frederick County, property owned by The
33	People-to-People Health Foundation, Inc. and used by it exclusively for benevolent and charitable
34	purposes on a nonprofit basis, as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be
35	exempt from taxation, State and local, including inheritance taxes.
36	§ 58.1-3650.246. Property of Westminster-Canterbury of Winchester, Inc.
37	A. The Westminster-Canterbury of Winchester, Inc., a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as
38	a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6 (a) (6) of Article X of the
39 40	Constitution of Virginia. B. Property That portion of property located partly in the City of Winchester and partly in the
40 41	County of Frederick <i>that is located in the City of Winchester and</i> owned by the Westminster-Canterbury
42	of Winchester, Inc., and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes, on a nonprofit
43	basis, as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby designated to be exempt from local taxation.
44	2. That §§ 58.1-3650.381, 58.1-3650.382, 58.1-3650.452, 58.1-3650.453, 58.1-3650.507, 58.1-3650.566,
45	58.1-3650.569, 58.1-3650.612, 58.1-3650.667, 58.1-3650.668, 58.1-3650.684, 58.1-3650.712,
46	58.1-3650.754, and 58.1-3650.755 of the Code of Virginia are repealed.
