Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 8 9 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-287.02 as follows: 10 § 22.1-287.02. Uniformed services-connected students. A. For purposes of this section, a "uniformed services-connected student" means a student enrolled 11 in a public school whose parent is serving in either (i) the active component of the U.S. Army, Navy, 12 Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, or National Guard, the Commissioned Corps of the National 13 Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, or the Commissioned Corps of the U.S. Public Health Services 14 15 or (ii) the reserve component of the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, or 16 National Guard. B. The Department of Education shall establish a process for the identification of newly enrolled 17 18 uniformed services-connected students by local school divisions. Local school divisions shall identify 19 newly enrolled uniformed services-connected students in accordance with such process. 20 C. Nonidentifiable, aggregate data collected from the identification of uniformed services-connected 21 students shall be made available to local, state, and federal entities for the purposes of enhancing the eligibility for non-Commonwealth budget funding and the quality of services provided to serve the needs 22 23 of uniformed services-connected students residing in the Commonwealth. 24 D. Data collected from the identification of uniformed services-connected students shall not be a 25 public record as defined in § 2.2-3701. No person shall disclose such data except as permitted under the provisions of the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. § 1232g) and related 26 27 regulations. No such data shall be used for the purposes of student achievement, the Standards of

28 Accreditation, student-growth indicators, the school performance report card, or any other school rating
29 system.
