11 12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered § 25.1-107.1 as follows:
12	§ 25.1-107.1. Agreements to obtain land for conservation easements; consent required; inverse condemnation.
13 14	A. In any instance where the Commonwealth, or any political subdivision thereof possessing the
15	power of eminent domain, for the purpose of mitigating or buffering the impact of an acquisition of land
16	for the purpose of public road construction, enters into an agreement to (i) obtain a conservation
17	easement on the property of a landowner who is not a party to the agreement or (ii) designate an area
18	consisting of private property upon which conservation easements would be imposed, the Commonwealth
19	shall first obtain the consent of all private landowners whose property would be the subject of the
20	matters in clause (i) or (ii), and any such landowner whose consent is not obtained shall have a cause
21	of action against the Commonwealth for inverse condemnation arising immediately upon the
22	Commonwealth's execution of an agreement as referred to in clause (i) or (ii). The agreement shall be
23	prima facie proof that the landowner's property was taken or damaged for the purposes of initiating
24	such action and the landowner may be awarded compensation in accordance with § 25.1-230 and costs
25	in accordance with § 25.1-420.
26	B. Clause (ii) of subsection A shall apply only to a claim for inverse condemnation brought (i) by
27	the person who was the record owner of the property on the date the Commonwealth entered into such
28	an agreement as referred to in subsection A or (ii) if the person who was the record owner of the
