7 WHEREAS, the Kettle Run High School marching band was awarded a top-ranked Superior rating
8 for 2014 at the Virginia Band and Orchestra Directors Association marching assessment held in October;

WHEREAS, the talented musicians from the Nokesville high school in Fauquier County are no
 strangers to performance excellence; since the school opened in 2008, the Kettle Run High School
 marching band has received six Superior ratings; and

WHEREAS, a Superior designation means that a marching band has received "superior" ratings from
 the seven people who are acting as adjudicators at the Virginia Band and Orchestra Directors
 Association assessment; and

WHEREAS, the theme for the Kettle Run marching band's 2014 season was "Apollo 13," and the music and the choreography spurred on the band as it rehearsed; the show's special effects included a simulated moon landing using high-tech props; and

WHEREAS, the Kettle Run High School marching band members and Matt Yonkey, director of
bands at the school, were focused on one goal for the 2014 season: ensuring that the judges would
award the band the greatly desired Superior rating—nothing less would do—and they succeeded; and

WHEREAS, throughout the fall, the Kettle Run High School marching band garnered top marks at
 competitions; it won first place at the Woodbridge Invitational in the Class AAAA division, the
 Loudoun Valley Invitational, the Millbrook High School Invitational in the Carolina class, and the
 Stafford Invitational; and

WHEREAS, the Kettle Run High School marching band is a five-time Virginia Honor Band; the
 strong support from parents, faculty and staff, and students has helped propel the marching band to
 success; now, therefore, be it

30 commend the Kettle Run High School marching band for receiving a Superior rating at the Virginia
31 Band and Orchestra Directors Association 2014 marching assessment; and, be it

 for presentation to Matt Yonkey, director of bands, as an expression of the General Assembly's
 congratulations and admiration for the outstanding achievements of the Kettle Run High School
