WHEREAS, on November 1, 2014, the woman's club celebrated 75 years of helping the community with a social at the Hale-Wilkinson-Carter Home in Hillsville, which was open to all; and

WHEREAS, in addition to honoring the club's history and early service projects, one of which was providing funding for the local library, the group also wants to attract new members to help keep the Hillsville Woman's Club healthy and vibrant in the future; now, therefore, be it
