*Celebrating the life of Jack Wayne Hunley.*

WHEREAS, Jack Wayne Hunley, who admirably served his Wythe County community as a member of the Wytheville Town Council, a veteran of the United States military, and a devoted husband and father, died on December 11, 2014; and

WHEREAS, a native of Wythe County, Jack Hunley graduated from George Wythe High School; he served in the United States Army from 1967 to 1969, where he became a staff sergeant and was awarded the Purple Heart and two Bronze Stars, one with valor, for his service in Vietnam; and

WHEREAS, Jack Hunley, a retired banker, served on the Wytheville Town Council from 1990 to 1994; he was elected to town council a second time in 2010 and was reelected in 2014; he was a member of the budget and finance committee and the Wytheville Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Jack Hunley was respected and liked by many people for helping those in need and for his reliability, honesty, and love of family and community; he was named a Stanley King Citizen of the Year in 2012 by the Wytheville-Wythe-Bland Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, Jack Hunley was a member of the Willow Brook Jackson/Umberger Homestead Museum Advisory Board and had been active in the Wytheville Jaycees, where he helped establish the Wall of Honor civic monument; he also belonged to American Legion Post 9 of Wythe County and the Wythe County Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 2719; and

WHEREAS, a man of faith, Jack Hunley shared his wisdom, insight, compassion, and sharp wit as a member of the choir and the finance committee of Mount Pleasant United Methodist Church; and

WHEREAS, Jack Hunley will be greatly missed and fondly remembered by his wife, Clenda; his daughter, Heather, and her family; and by many family members and friends; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby note with great sadness the loss of Jack Wayne Hunley, a dedicated public servant and member of the Wytheville Town Council, who willingly helped his neighbors and worked for the betterment of the people of Wytheville; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to the family of Jack Wayne Hunley as an expression of the General Assembly's respect for his memory.
