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11	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth has adopted a comprehensive stormwater management program to
12 13	protect the Commonwealth's surface waters, including the Chesapeake Bay, from the negative impacts of stormwater pollutants, including excess nutrients and sediment, being washed from developed sites
14	during storm events; and
15	WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality administers the Commonwealth's
16 17	stormwater management program in accordance with the Stormwater Management Act and attendant regulations; and
18	WHEREAS, a seasonal high groundwater table in some areas of the Commonwealth can hinder the
19 20	use of best management practices (BMPs) that can be employed in other parts of the Commonwealth to
20 21	control the quantity of stormwater leaving a developed site; and WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Quality is best positioned to study this issue and to
22	make recommendations to achieve greater flexibility in applying the water quantity requirements of the
23 24	Stormwater Management Act and regulations in areas with a seasonal high groundwater table while protecting the Commonwealth's surface waters; now, therefore, be it
24 25	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Department of
26	Environmental Quality be requested to study the application of the postdevelopment stormwater
27 28	management technical criteria, as established in the Virginia Stormwater Management Regulations, in areas with a seasonal high groundwater table.
20 29	In conducting its study, the Department of Environmental Quality shall include a review of any
30	applicable literature on this topic, in order to determine additional BMPs that can be employed or other
31 32	means of achieving greater flexibility in meeting the stormwater management requirements in those areas.
33	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Department of Environmental
34 35	Quality for this study, upon request. The Department of Environmental Quality shall complete its meetings for the first year by November
35 36	30, 2015, and for the second year by November 30, 2016, and the Director shall submit to the Governor
37	and the General Assembly an executive summary and report of its findings and recommendations for
38 39	publication as a House or Senate document for each year. The executive summaries and reports shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the
40	processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of the next Regular Session of
41	the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website.
