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10	WHEREAS, the Metrorail reduces traffic congestion in the Northern Virginia region; and
11	WHEREAS, an extension of the Metrorail may have an effect on the current and future service
12	provided by the Virginia Railway Express; and
13	WHEREAS, bus transit may be a feasible alternative to an expansion of either the Virginia Railway
14	Express or the Metrorail; and
15	WHEREAS, the projected ridership and potential costs of expansion in Northern Virginia are
16	unknown; now, therefore, be it
17	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Department of Rail and
18	Public Transportation be requested to study the efficacy and desirability of extending the Metrorail in
19 20	Virginia. The Department of Rail and Public Transportation shall study a potential extension of the Material from Springfield Virginia courts along the LOS corridor in Prince William County
20 21	Metrorail from Springfield, Virginia, south along the I-95 corridor in Prince William County. In conducting its study, the Department of Rail and Public Transportation shall compare (i) the
21 22	potential effect of an extension of the Metrorail to Prince William County on reducing congestion in the
23	region with the potential effect of an extension of the Virginia Railway Express on reducing congestion
23 24	in the region, (ii) the projected ridership of an extension of the Metrorail with that of an extension of
25	the Virginia Railway Express, and (iii) the potential costs of either such extension.
26	Technical assistance shall be provided to the Department of Rail and Public Transportation by the
27	Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission and the Department of Transportation. All agencies of
28	the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Department of Rail and Public Transportation for this
29	study, upon request.
30	The Department of Rail and Public Transportation shall complete its meetings by November 30,
31	2015, and shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report
32	of its findings and recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive
33	summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative
34	Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of
35	the 2016 Regular Session of the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's

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website.

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
